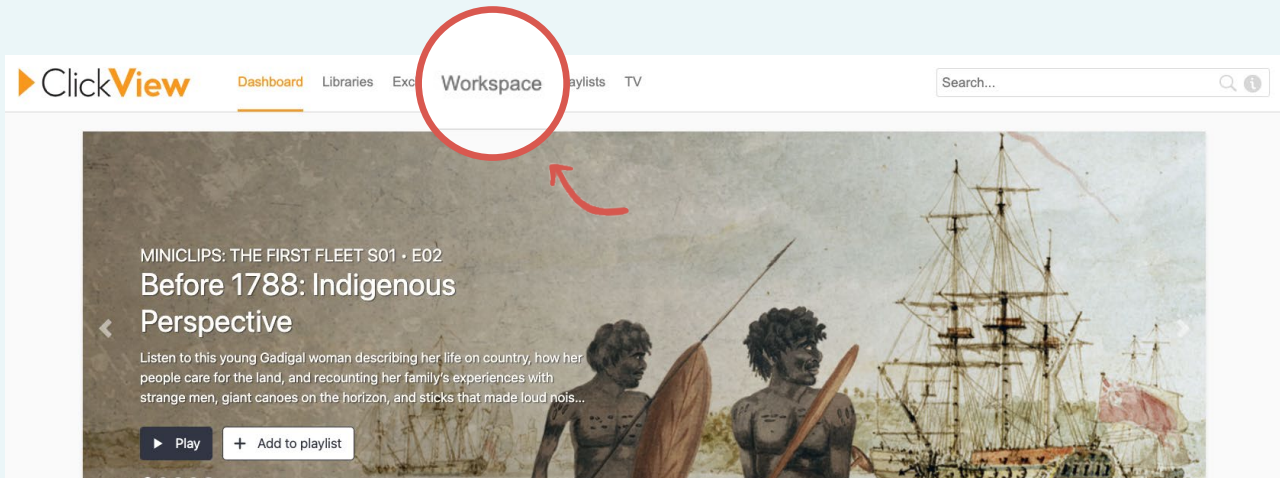

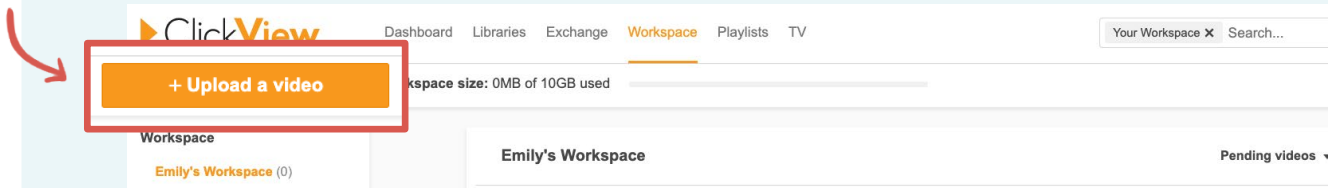
1. Access your 'Workspace'

3. Click on the 'Workspace' tab at the top of the screen:

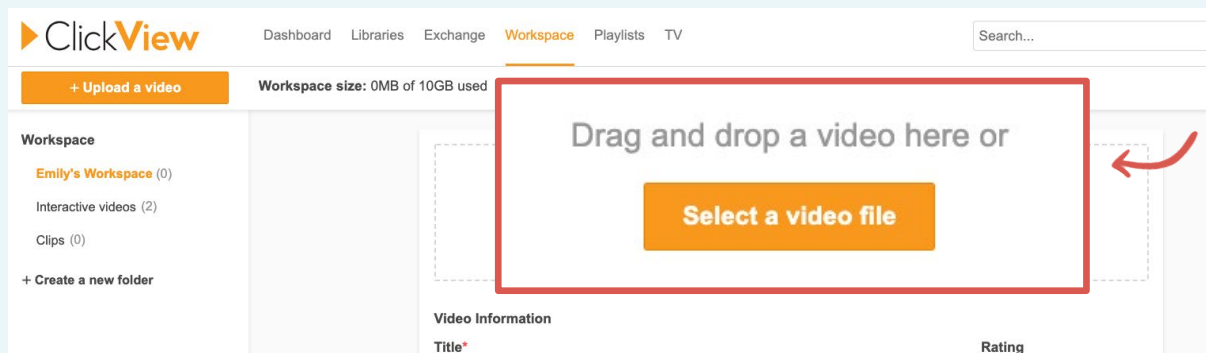


2. Upload video to your Workspace

2. Select 'Upload':

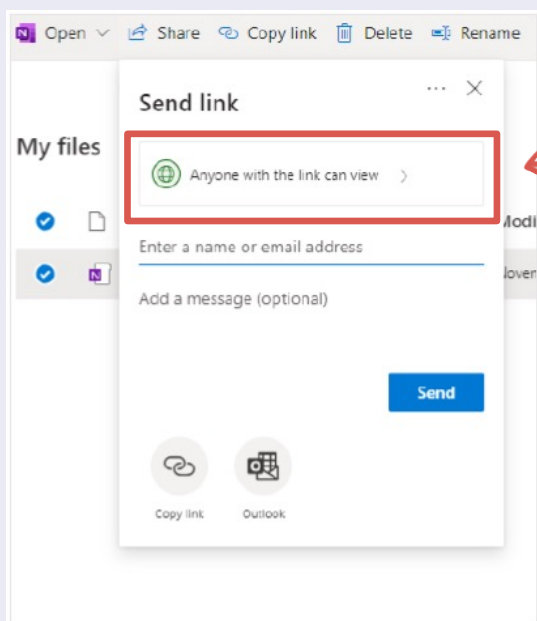


3. Select the files you want to upload, and then select 'Open'.

1. Go to the [OneDrive website](#) and sign in with your Microsoft account
2. Pick the video file you want to share by selecting the circle in the upper corner
3. Select 'Share' at the top of the page
4. Select 'Anyone with the link can view':



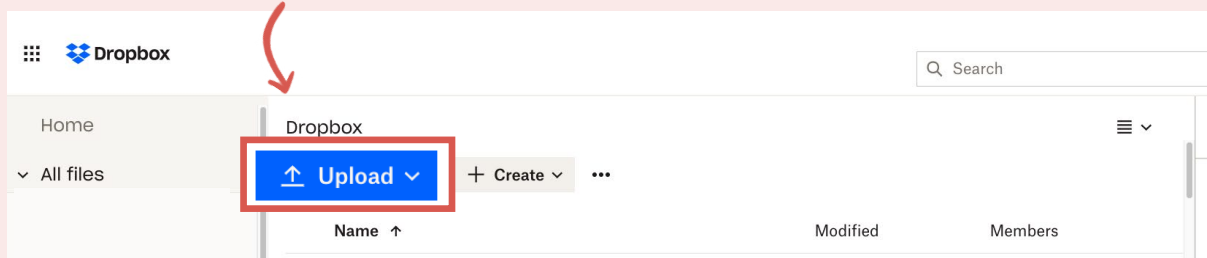
5. Select Copy Link to copy the link

2. Click the 'Upload files' button:

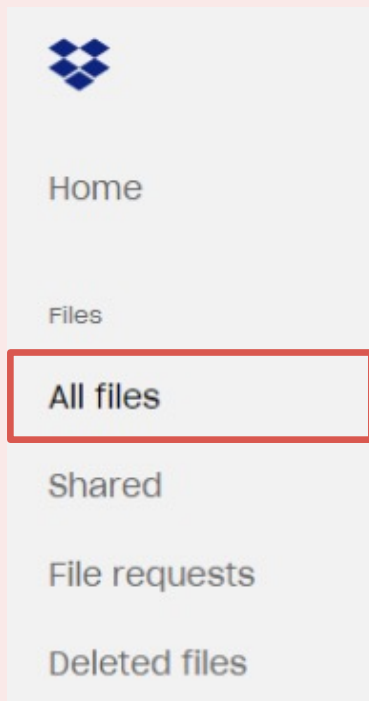


3. Click 'Choose Files', and then double-click the file you want to add.

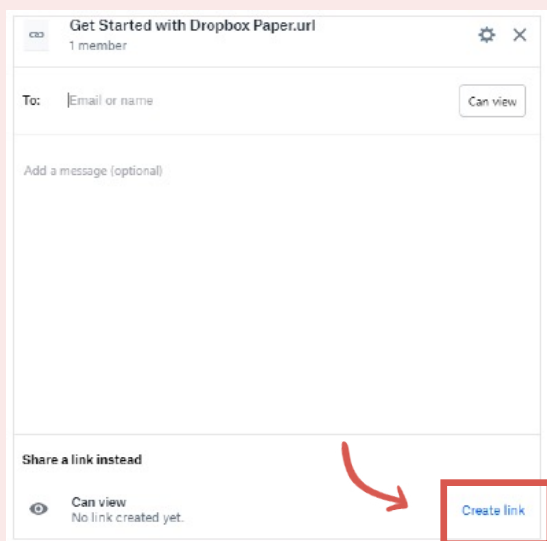
How to share a video link from Dropbox

2. Click 'All files' in the left sidebar:

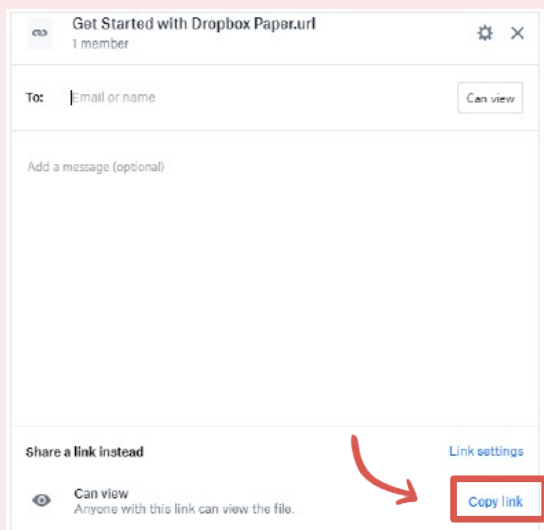


3. Hover over the name of the file you'd like to share and click 'Share'.

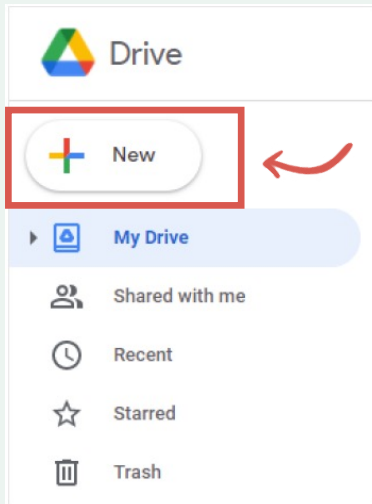

How to upload a video to Google Drive

1. Go to drive.google.com
2. Sign in with your Google Account
3. At the top left, click 'New' then select 'File Upload':

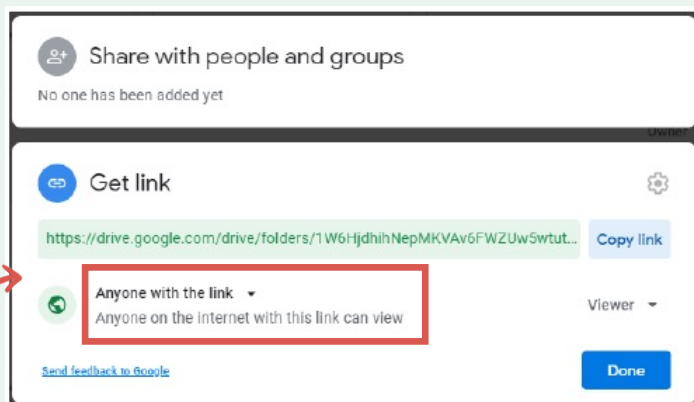


4. Choose the video file you want to upload.

How to share a video link from Google Drive

1. Sign into drive.google.com.
2. Select the file you want to share
3. Click 'Share' or 'Share Get link'.
4. Under 'Get Link', click the Down arrow or 'Change'.
5. Change the sharing settings to 'Anyone with the link' and 'Viewer':



6. Click Copy link and then click Done
7. Paste the link in the entry form on the [Aussie Student Inventions competition page](#).
