Create Your Own Dreamscape

'And as imagination bodies forth
The forms of things unknown, the poet's pen
Turns them to shapes, and gives to airy nothing
A local habitation and a name.' Act 5, Scene 1

Now let **your** imagination go! Close your eyes for a minute or two, and imagine a different world.

It could be:

- an ideal landscape, perhaps based on somewhere you have been;
- somewhere you have always wanted to visit;
- a totally strange, fantastical world;
- an undiscovered planet; or
- a place from the past.

Plan a description of the place, appealing to all the five senses: sight, sound, touch, taste and smell. The place can contain people or creatures.

Write a poem or description of your imagined place. Try to create a definite atmosphere in your description or poem, e.g. a sense of mystery, happiness or sadness. Aim to evoke emotions in the reader.
